This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

White Chanterelle Timber Sale #80885 and Forest Practice Application #2809609 is an even aged harvest of 1,278 MBF of timber from 37.7 acres. Proposal includes 972 feet of road construction and up to 2,057 feet of temporary road construction (to be built, then abandoned after completion of use). Located in Sections 03 and 04, Township 37 North, Range 04 East, Section 01, Township 39 North, Range 05 East and Section 19, Township 37 North, Range 05 East, W.M., Whatcom County.
